## **October Membership Meeting**

On Saturday, October 16, Division 9 will be visiting two layouts in the greater Lansing, MI area.

At the Division 5 NCR Convention in Lansing in October 2018, I visited both of these layouts and was very impressed and have been wanting to make another visit for an update on construction, progress, operations and new photos. - Rich Mahaney

**LAYOUT #1** - 10:00 AM, we will start at the DM&IR layout of a father/son building team of Dave Verzke and his son Rob Venzke. This railroad models traffic from the DM&IR, Great Northern, Norther Pacific, Soo Line, Milwaukee Road. This layout is described as a "club size layout in



a building behind a home". This is a layout that focuses on the DM&IR operations in northern MN in the 1950/1960's moving iron ore from the MN mines to the docks in Duluth. The layout is an HO scale layout that is under construction.

#### The address is:7511 S Chandler RD, St John's MI 48879.



After the DM&IR layout tour, photos and discussions we will stop for a short lunch break as we travel to Haslett (east of Lansing/East Lansing) to the second layout. So we should be at the second layout around between **12noon and 1pm**.

LAYOUT #2 - our next layout is in the home of Tom Weaver in the basement. We will be wearing facemasks at Tom's layout tour. Tom models the CP railroad in HO scale in Southern Ontario.
Tom's address is 6029 Oakpark Trail, Haslett, MI 48840.



Tom provided the following layout description:

1) 1984 and based on Sudbury to Webbwood on CP Rail branch to Sault Ste. Marie and a connection with Soo Line and Algoma Central there. Real Webbwood was a Division Point until ~1980 (maybe a bit earlier) and still is on our pike since everything west of there is represented by staging in the double-ended fiddle yard. Lower level represents the Little Current Subdivision that extended to the North Channel of Lake Huron and Manitoulin Island until mid-1990's.

2) roughly 25 x 49 feet max.



3) timetable and train orders. Car cards and waybills. No signals although I like signals well enough I might signal a part of it.





4) Two-level layout with ~90 ft fivelevel helix. Controlled by Digitrax DCC. All trains followed across layout using radio throttles. Double-ended fiddle yard and off track storage reduce the "looks the same" concept that staging yard layouts have. We have only officially operated four times (all pre-COVID). One time since was just done unofficially to keep the cobwebs lubed up. We hope to begin



valance installation and new lighting as soon as this tour is completed.

Parking at the Layouts:

Layout #1 last time I was there we parked on the grass by the building.

Layout #2 last time I was there we parked on the neighborhood streets by the house.
